

Support and guidances stems for participants with special needs

Admission

Both the admissions procedure and the exams and requirements for access have been created according to that established in articles 16 and 17 of Real Decreto 1393/2007 (Spanish Royal Decree 1393/2007). In this sense, participants with special needs during the admissions process will have a mentor who will assess their needs in the context of the Master in Management (MiM)

Monitoring of the participant

It is important for participants with special needs to inform the program about their requirements, in order to implement the necessary measures. The areas in which the program offers help to participants of the MiM include the search for accommodations suited to the needs of the participant, their location in class, allocation of additional time during exams, etc.

Each participant has an academic mentor who will take them in and advise them as soon as they join until the end of their academic run so that they may meet the objectives of the training program efficiently and in the time established. The mentors will take special care of cases with participants with special needs and will assess the need for possible changes to the curriculum.
